



QUARTZ SURFACE CARE & MAINTENANCE

For daily cleaning of quartz surfaces use warm water and dish soap. Tougher spots may require a non-abrasive cleaner (***Method Daily Granite***) or mild degreaser (***Vim***). For stuck on materials such as food, gum, or nail polish, use a plastic putty knife to scrape away, then remove any residue with ***Method Daily Granite***. Rinse and surfaces should look like new again.

| Common Household Spills: | Cleaning Product: | Instructions: |
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| <p>Food coloring, herbs and spices, red wine, mustard, coffee/tea, fruits, ink, markers, permanent markers, paint, print from supermarket bags.</p> | <p><i>Method Daily Granite</i></p> <p>Alcohol (Methyl Hydrate)</p> <p>100% Acetone</p> | <p>Clean the surface with either Method Daily Granite or alcohol, using a cloth or paper towel.</p> <p>*If the mark persists, use a cotton pad saturated with acetone to gently rub the mark for a few seconds. Once this step is completed, rinse the surface clean with a clean wet cloth or paper towel.</p> |
| <p>Oil (synthetic or natural):</p> <p>Includes marks such as: olive oil, canola oil, machine oils, etc.</p> | <p>Cleaning Product:</p> <p><i>Method Daily Granite</i></p> <p>10% bleach (natural only)</p> <p>Hydrogen peroxide, max. 30% (natural only)</p> <p>Mild, alcohol-based degreaser</p> | <p>Instructions:</p> <p>Apply a delicate cleaning product to surface if soap and water does not suffice. Allow to sit for approximately 5 minutes. Wipe clean with a damp cloth or paper towel and material disintegrates with ease.</p> |

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| <p>Cosmetics:</p> <p>Includes marks such as: hair shampoo, medical creams, make-up.</p> | <p>Cleaning Product:</p> <p>Alcohol (Methyl Hydrate)</p> <p><i>Method Daily Granite</i></p> <p>Hydrogen peroxide, max. 30%</p> | <p>Instructions:</p> <p>Apply the cleaning product to a damp cloth or directly to the surface. After 3-5 minutes, wipe with clean cloth.</p> |
| <p>Metal Marks:</p> <p>Includes marks such as: metal kitchen tools such as knives, metal pots, metal belt buckles.</p> | <p>Cleaning Product:</p> <p>White (non-sanded) latex eraser</p> | <p>Instructions:</p> <p>Gently use a white latex eraser on the metal mark, as you would a pencil mark and simply wipe clean with a damp cloth. If necessary, use Method Daily Granite on site of the mark.</p> |
| <p>Metal Rust</p> | <p>Cleaning Product:</p> <p>Oxalic Acid <i>(Bar Keepers Friend)</i></p> | <p>Instructions:</p> <p>Apply a cream or powdered cleaning product to the rust mark. (If using powder, leave a wet cloth or paper towel on top to keep powder moist.) Let it sit for 10 minutes and then gently wipe clean with a wet cloth or paper towel. Rinse all product from surface and wipe with a clean cloth. Repeat use for stubborn marks.</p> |
| <p>Other:</p> <p>Blood, candle wax, glue from adhesive tape, soap stains, hard water deposits.</p> | <p>Cleaning Product:</p> <p><i>Method Daily Granite</i></p> <p>Alcohol (Methyl Hydrate)</p> <p>Vinegar</p> | <p>Instructions:</p> <p>For tougher deposits, use alcohol or an alcohol-based degreaser. Let sit for 2 minutes and wipe with damp cloth or paper towel. To remove hard water deposits, treat surface with vinegar.</p> |
